Fortune-Telling, Psychics, Astrology, Mediums, Halloween ~ Leader's Guide

1. Read Luke 16:19-31 (Story of the Rich Man and Lazarus). According to Jesus, what are chances of us hearing from the dead? Not going to happen.

Luke $16:19-31 - {}^{19}$ "There was a rich man who was dressed in purple and fine linen and lived in luxury every day. 20 At his gate was laid a beggar named Lazarus, covered with sores 21 and longing to eat what fell from the rich man's table. Even the dogs came and licked his sores.

²² "The time came when the beggar died and the angels carried him to Abraham's side. The rich man also died and was buried. ²³ In hell, where he was in torment, he looked up and saw Abraham far away, with Lazarus by his side. ²⁴ So he called to him, 'Father Abraham, have pity on me and send Lazarus to dip the tip of his finger in water and cool my tongue, because I am in agony in this fire.'

²⁵ "But Abraham replied, 'Son, remember that in your lifetime you received your good things, while Lazarus received bad things, but now he is comforted here and you are in agony. ²⁶ And besides all this, between us and you a great chasm has been fixed, so that those who want to go from here to you cannot, nor can anyone cross over from there to us.'

²⁷ "He answered, 'Then I beg you, father, send Lazarus to my father's house, ²⁸ for I have five brothers. Let him warn them, so that they will not also come to this place of torment.'

²⁹ "Abraham replied, 'They have Moses and the Prophets; let them listen to them.'

³⁰ " 'No, father Abraham,' he said, 'but if someone from the dead goes to them, they will repent.'

³¹ "He said to him, 'If they do not listen to Moses and the Prophets, they will not be convinced even if someone rises from the dead.' "

2. How could a medium give someone information about a loved one? Only with the help of a demon. And it wouldn't necessarily be the truth.

3. Does God say anywhere in these verses that spirits don't exist? <u>No</u>

4. What is the big bottom line for us? <u>Don't do it! (Practice divination, sorcery,</u> witchcraft, interpret omens, cast spells, consult the dead, etc.)

5. Galatians 5:19-21. What work of the flesh [KJV] or act of sinful nature [NIV] refers to the passage above? <u>Witchcraft</u>

Galatians $5:19-21 - {}^{19}$ The acts of the sinful nature are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; 20 idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions 21 and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God.

What does Paul say will happen to those who practice this? (5:21) <u>They will not inherit</u> the kingdom of God.

Isaiah $47:12-15 - {}^{12}$ "Keep on, then, with your magic spells and with your many sorceries, which you have labored at since childhood. Perhaps you will succeed, perhaps you will cause terror.

¹³ All the counsel you have received has only worn you out! Let your astrologers come forward, those stargazers who make predictions month by month, let them save you from what is coming upon you. ¹⁴ Surely they are like stubble; the fire will burn them up. They cannot even save themselves from the power of the flame. Here are no coals to warm anyone; here is no fire to sit by. ¹⁵ That is all they can do for you—these you have labored with and trafficked with since childhood. Each of them goes on in his error; there is not one that can save you.

7. Isaiah 8:18-20. Isaiah says: <u>Why consult the dead when you can inquire of God?</u>

Isaiah $8:18-20 - {}^{18}$ Here am I, and the children the Lord has given me. We are signs and symbols in Israel from the Lord Almighty, who dwells on Mount Zion. 19 When men tell you to consult mediums and spiritists, who whisper and mutter, should not a people inquire of their God? Why consult the dead on behalf of the living? 20 To the law and to the testimony! If they do not speak according to this word, they have no light of dawn.

6. 1 Chronicles 10:13-14. One reason Saul died: <u>He consulted a medium</u>

1 Chronicles $10:13-14 - {}^{13}$ Saul died because he was unfaithful to the Lord; he did not keep the word of the Lord and even consulted a medium for guidance, 14 and did not inquire of the Lord. So the Lord put him to death and turned the kingdom over to David son of Jesse.

7. 2 Chronicles 33:1-6. What was God's reaction to Manasseh? He was angry

2 Chronicles 33:1-6 – ¹Manasseh was twelve years old when he became king, and he reigned in Jerusalem fifty-five years. ² He did evil in the eyes of the Lord, following the detestable practices of the nations the Lord had driven out before the Israelites. ³ He rebuilt the high places his father Hezekiah had demolished; he also erected altars to the Baals and made Asherah poles. He bowed down to all the starry hosts and worshiped them. ⁴ He built altars in the temple of the Lord, of which the Lord had said, "My Name will remain in Jerusalem forever." ⁵ In both courts of the temple of the Lord, he built altars to all the starry hosts. ⁶ He sacrificed his sons in the fire in the Valley of Ben Hinnom, practiced sorcery, divination and witchcraft, and consulted mediums and spiritists. He did much evil in the eyes of the Lord, provoking him to anger.

8. What happens to you if you turn to mediums or spiritists? You will be defiled

Leviticus 19:31 – Do not turn to mediums or seek out spiritists, for you will be defiled by them. I am the Lord your God.
